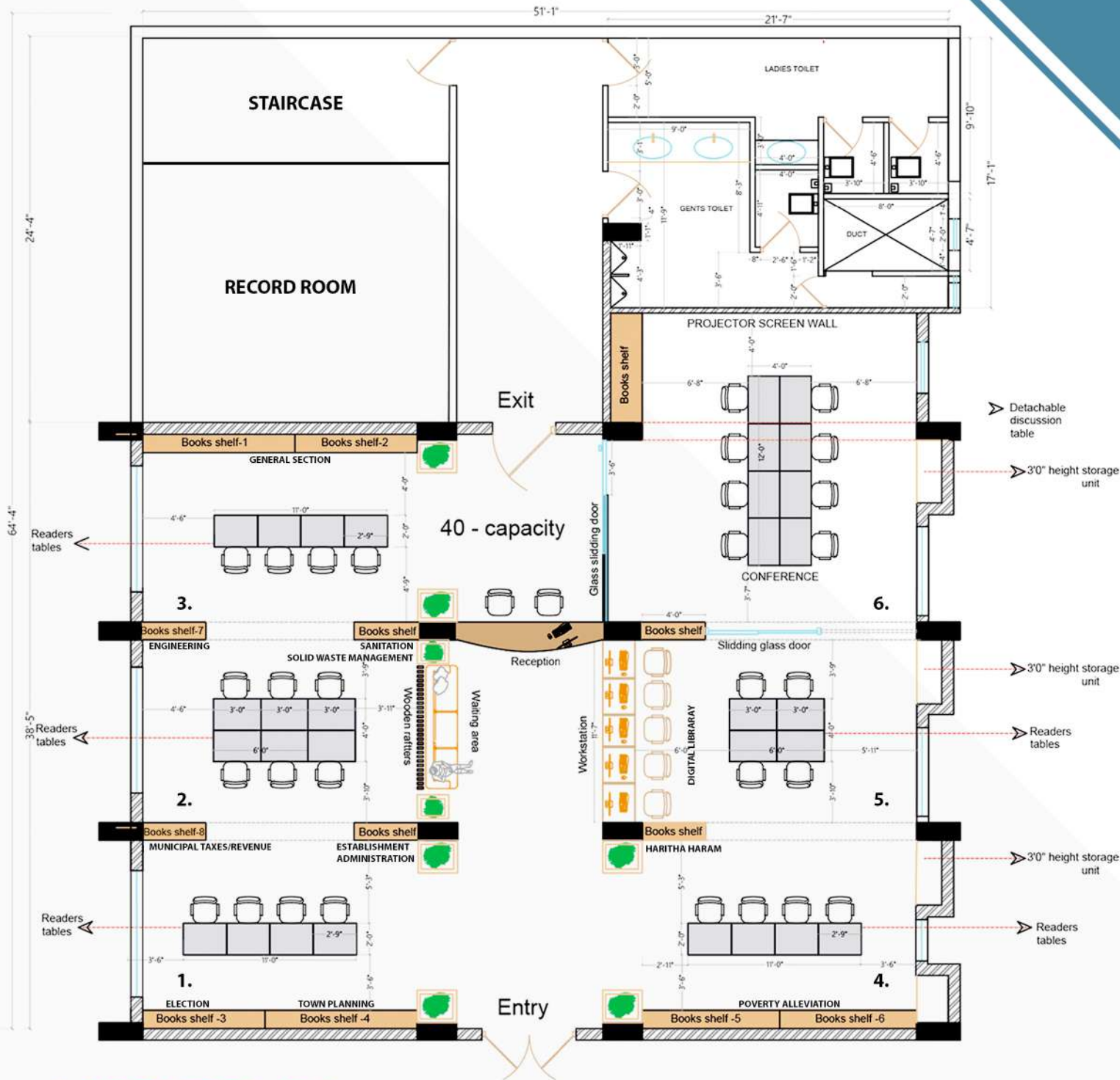


Vision:

- To conduct awareness programs for dissemination of new schemes or missions launched by GoT and Gol from time to time.

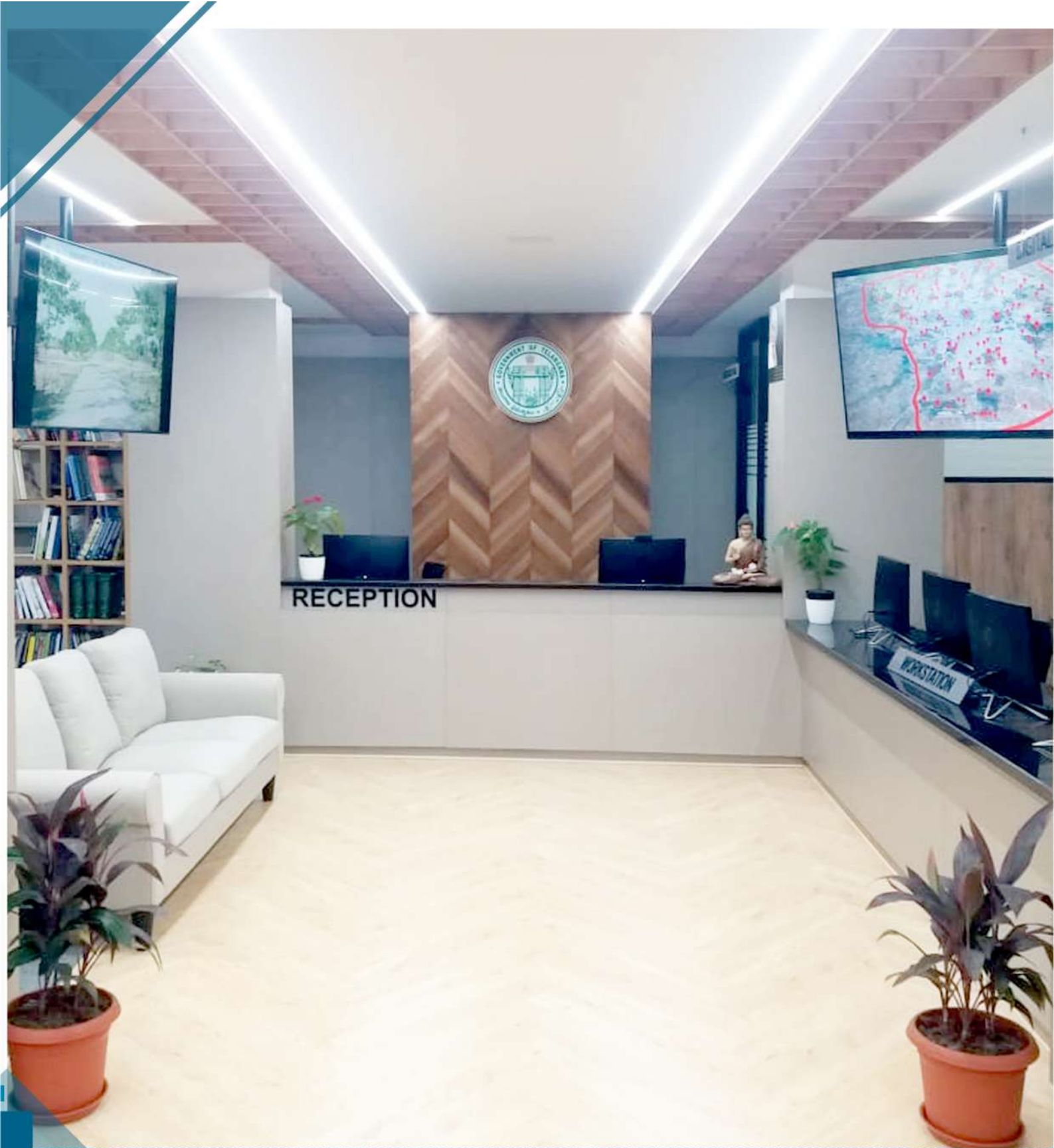


LAYOUT PLAN

AREA STATEMENT



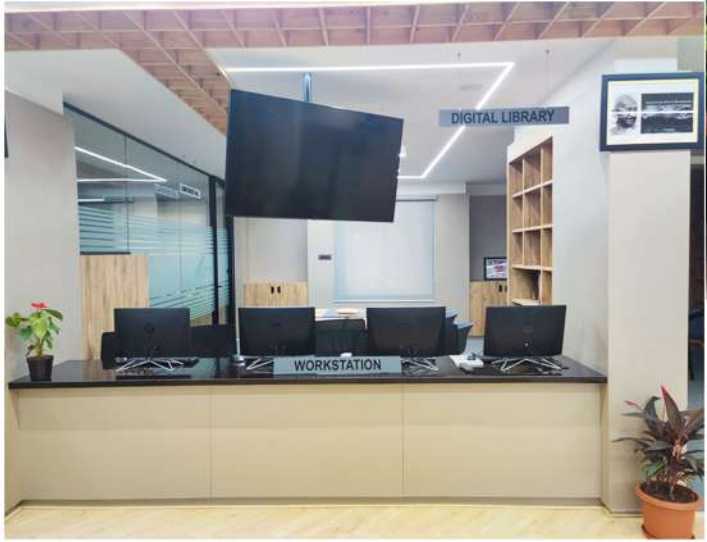
Uniqueness:
